HALL OF FAME PROCESS

Detailed information regarding nominations, qualifying criteria and the selection process is shown below.

NOMINATIONS: any official can nominate another official for this honor. Nominations may be submitted to a board member at any time. The list of board members is [online here](#).

QUALIFICATIONS

Nominee ...

1. Must have officiated at least twelve (12) years at Texas A&M hosted Outdoor/Indoor Track & Field competitions (Meets at other locations, whether local, national or international levels, are not considered).
2. Preference is given to those with experience in multiple events or responsibilities at local, regional (NCAA), conference (Southwest Conference, Big 12, South East Conference), and national (NCAA & AIAW) level competitions at Texas A&M.
3. Preference is given to those displaying leadership responsibilities and qualities officiating at a minimum of one national-level meet as a head official, coordinator, or administrator at Texas A&M.
4. Be recognized and respected by his/her peers for superior officiating skills.

** USA Track & Field membership and/or certification is recognized but not required.*

REVIEW

Voting will be conducted by

- the current Board of Directors (BOD),
- previous Hall of Fame inductees (optional), and
- two active TAMTFOA members (approved and selected by the BOD).

&

SELECTION

Voting will occur annually and conducted at a BOD meeting.

Any voting members unable to attend will be allowed to submit their votes by email to the BOD. Annually, based on a majority vote by the BOD, three (3) officials will be inducted into the Hall of Fame.
